

Poetry Reading in Siegen – George Ellenbogen presents his works

It was in the cozy atmosphere of the Shellack in Siegen where George Ellenbogen, a renowned Canadian writer, read from his poetry collection “Morning Gothic”, as well as from his and his late wife’s recently published memoirs.

Approximately 30 students and employees of Siegen University attended the event. He started the reading by presenting a few of his poems and answering questions about them concerning their meaning, his ideas for them and his working process.
