What does MUN stand for and why would we hold a simulation of a UN Session?

MUN or Model United Nations is an academic simulation of the United Nations. The UN is unique in that it is the one and only world organization with 193 member states. A model simulation of a session of this organization offers participants a perfect environment for learning about the UN. During the simulated sessions, participants work as UN representatives. They negotiate and discuss international politics just as the member states they represent do, and even the specific rules and regulations concerning behavior and diplomacy between states are observed and honored.

Why should I participate?

MUN puts into practice what economic, political and cultural institutions demand: You develop the tools for an active and responsible participation in society, creating solutions for a more humane world of tomorrow.

Experiences in the area of international exchange and cooperation are highly desired in an era of globalization and will be very appreciated by your future employer.
