

Detailed information about the examinations of the summer term 2021

July 29th 2021

Getting to the university

During the exam period, the regular bus lines will be reinforced on line 106. Please make sure that you arrive at least 30 minutes before the start of the exam (and even earlier if you are not sure at which entrance you will be admitted to the university buildings, see below). If possible, please choose an earlier bus to arrive at the campus on time.

Obligatory COVID-19-Testing

For all examinations as of August 9, 2021, faculty, staff, and students are required to show a proof of immunization (vaccinated or recovered), negative test evidence, or a negative result of a supervised self-test. The test proofs must not be older than 48 hours. With these rules, the University of Siegen implements all requirements, which take effect when the district of Siegen-Wittgenstein or the state of North Rhine-Westphalia reaches incidence level 2. All students and faculty who are not vaccinated or recovered are urged to have a COVID-19 test done in advance at a testing center or to take advantage of an equivalent testing offer. In cases where this is not possible, supervised self-testing has been made available on the Adolf Reichwein campus in the AR-HB building ("Hardter Berg School") starting August 2, 2021. Testing will be possible Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 10 a.m. and from 4 p.m. to 6 p.m., and on August 7 and 28 from 4 p.m. to 6 p.m. The tests will be handed out by trained personnel, who will also explain how to perform the tests; the testing itself has to be done by all students or employees of the university themselves. The test result is documented in written form which can be used for internal university purposes only. This test certificate is not valid outside the University of Siegen. ATTENTION: Please take into account that the waiting time at the self-test stations can hardly be estimated. It is recommended to either take a test at a test center or to take a self-test one or two days (not more than 48 hours) before an exam each time.

Admission to university buildings

All exams with more than 20 participants will take place at the AR campus. All examinees are admitted to the university buildings by a supervisor **20 minutes before the examination starts**. It is not allowed to enter university buildings before admission or to wait in front of the examination room for entrance. Proof of immunization or negative test results will be checked at the entrance.

There is a specific entrance for each examination room, which is described in the following tables. It is also marked on the maps in the appendix. Members of the University's security team are also available on site to answer questions. Please make sure that you wait for admission near the correct entrance. You will not be able to enter the university building once the doors are closed after admittance!

Please remember to be prepared to wait outside in bad weather. And even if it is difficult: it is strictly prohibited to gather in crowds. Please keep your distance while waiting and wear your mouth-and-nose-covering.

Wearing a mouth-and-nose covering is obligatory (exception: medical reasons, in this case please show the corresponding medical certificate); if you do not wear it, you will not be allowed into the building or you may be excluded from the exam. If you have respiratory symptoms, e.g. cough, or fever, please do not enter the premises of the University of Siegen (exception: a cold clarified by a doctor).



Getting to the examination room

Please also keep your distance on the way to the examination room and wear your mouth-and-nose-covering. In some buildings, footpaths and one-way street regulations are marked as well as designated entrances and exits; the respective regulations must be observed.

Inside the examination room: preparation

Seats that may be taken are marked with a green sticker; all other seats must not be occupied. Please take the seat that is assigned to you. For the next step you will need your smartphone, your student ID and a photo ID (identity card, passport etc.). You will continue to wear the mouth-and-nose-covering.

Before the beginning of the examination, the supervisors will go through the rows to first check whether you are registered for the examination (student ID and photo ID), and secondly to create an digital attendance list in the case that a chain of infections would need to be traced afterwards. The attendance list is created by scanning a QR code the supervisors will present to you and by entering your data in the registration form. Scanning works using a QR code app, but on many smartphone models it is also possible to simply point the camera at the QR code and then open the browser. If the QR code does not work, open the URL of the registration mask (https://uni-siegen.corona-erfassung.de/) and enter the identification number of your examination, which will be provided by the supervisors alternatively. If technical problems should occur, printed out lists are available for you to sign.

Afterwards, please turn off your smartphone, put it in your bag and place it at your feet together with your jacket etc. so that you cannot reach it during the examination (do not place items at the edge/wall to avoid unnecessary walks). Only writing tools, food and drinks as well as any approved aids are allowed on the table.

Please remember that keeping a smartphone close to you (in trouser pockets or somewhere similar) may be considered as an attempt to cheat!

If there are further, specific rules for your examination (e.g. regarding the distribution of the examination sheets, questions about the examination, toilet visits, etc.), these rules will be announced by the supervisory staff or announced in advance.

During the examination

You can take off your mouth-and-nose-covering during the examination. If you have finished the examination before the scheduled end, please stay in your place; leaving the examination room early is not allowed.

After the examination

Please put your mouth-and-nose covering back on and remain seated while the examinations are being collected. When this is completed, please leave the room one after another while keeping a distance from each other.



Please leave the university building in the direction of the exit as indicated for your examination room (follow the signs or instructions of the supervisory staff). And again, please refrain from standing together in groups, even if you would like to discuss the examination. The University is legally obliged to ensure that examinations to not lead to crowds or gathering of people that constitute a risk of infection - we are relying on your sense of responsibility.
