

Master degree programme Chemistry Important information and deadlines valid in the winter term 2025/2026

All academic achievements: examinations, exercises, presentations, laboratory courses etc. excluding third attempts and thesis should be registered by students through unisono in due time! It is not possible to take an examination, conduct a laboratory course without the respective registration for these academic achievements in unisono.

The registrations for exams or other academic achievements should be done separately from the registrations for the respective lectures / tutorials. It means that a registration for a lecture, exercises or laboratory courses is not a requirement or a registration for an examination itself or a coursework itself. The structure of the modules can be seen in unisono. For example, the module Applied Analytical Chemistry:

After uninterrupted participation in the degree programme, a failed written or oral examination shall be considered not taken (**free attempt**) upon a request to the examination office, provided the following requirements are fulfilled:

- 1. the module has to be completed before or during the semester to which it is assigned according to the degree plan for the master's degree programme and
- 2. the examination has to be taken during the first examination period of the respective semester and has not been repeated according to §12 (5) of the RPO-M and
- 3. the examination must be repeated in the second examination period of the same semester.

Improvements should be done during the second examination period of the same semester, that is directly after the passed free attempt.

Registration for the examinations in the second examination period (as a part of the free attempt regulation) should be done through the examination office within the respective registration deadlines.

Additionally, there is a possibility to **improve** a grade in **one module of choice** (excl. master thesis). This improvement should be done in the fourth semester. Registration must be done during the respective registration period through the examination office.

A finally failed compulsory module may be remedied by a **supplementary oral examination**. The application should be done through the examination office within four weeks and must be conducted within six weeks after the announcement of the grade. This oral exam can be done in the sixth semester at the latest. The examination board shall decide upon the application. A retake of this oral exam is not permitted.

The first examination period starts on February, 9th and ends on February, 20th 2026.

Registration through unisono for this period starts on Jnuary, 19th and ends on February, 2nd 2026 (11:59 p.m.).

The second examination period starts on March, 16th and ends on March, 27th 2026.

Registration through unisono for this period starts on February, 23rd and ends on March, 9th 2026 (11:59 p.m.).

Registration of courseworks: exercises, protocolls, presentation and laboratory courses should be done through unisono from October, 1st until February, 22nd 2026.

Should you face problems while signing in for the exams please contact the examination office immediately (however, on the next working day after the end of the relevant registration period at the latest!). Screenshots of error messages or disorders might be helpful.

Regular withdrawal should be done through unisono **seven** days prior to the examination date. Unisono system calculates the exact time depending on the beginning of the respective examination.

Withdrawal in case of serious reasons (for example due to a sickness) should be done through the examination office immediately (however, within 3 working days after the examination date at the latest!).
