

How to enroll for courses and lectures

You can enroll for courses either via the university's course catalogue or the planner of studies with module plan.

In the course catalogue you can find any course offered by the university.

The planner of studies with module plan only displays the courses that are curricular components of your degree program, i.e. that are credited within the scope of your course of study.

Enrolling via planner of studies

To enroll for courses via the planner of studies please select My Studies in the menu.

Please make sure that the green marked selection reads “Show Module plan” (a). If need be, please change your selection for this setting (“Examination regulations”).


Please select the semester in which you want to enroll for courses (b).
