The **main tasks** of the doctoral student and research assistant are

- research on retailing, e-commerce and/or international strategy
- contribution to company projects in the fields of **retailing, e-commerce and international strategy**
- teaching and coordinating exercises (mainly case studies)
- tutorial assistance for students writing their master thesis or seminar thesis.

It is also expected that the assistant prepares a **doctoral thesis** in one of the above-mentioned research areas. **50% of the working time** is reserved for own research. The duration of the dissertation project is ca. 4 years.

The following **qualifications** are required for this position:

- an above average **university** master's degree in management, with a specialisation in retail management, international management and/or marketing
- strong motivation
- interest in and capability for academic management research
- mother tongue German, very good language skills in English. Language skills in French are an asset.
