

## **Election Notice**

**Notice is hereby given that**

**from 16 June 2026 to 29 June 2026**

**elections will be held for the 53rd Student Parliament and the Faculty Councils of the University of Siegen.**

### **1. Voting and Timeline**

The elections for the 53rd Student Parliament and the Faculty Councils of the University of Siegen will take place from 16 June 2026 to 29 June 2026 exclusively as an e-vote.

Voting will take place via the portal of the service provider Electric Paper. The student email address (g-number + password) will be used to verify identity and thus eligibility to exercise the right to vote.

### **2. Voting locations**

Polling stations will be set up on several campuses for voting, and the premises of the University of Siegen's central election office on the Adolf-Reichwein Campus will be made available.

Further polling stations will be open from 22 June to 26 June on the Unteres Schloss and Paul Bonatz campuses. On the

notices will be displayed, which will direct you to the election portal.

Otherwise, it is possible to vote via the election portal throughout the entire voting period. You can take part in the election via a digital device, regardless of your location, using the following link: <https://uni-siegen.gremienwahlen.de/election/200/public/login>

### **3. Nominations**

Nominations must be received by the Election Committee via the student email address by 22 May at the latest. The Election Committee can only be contacted via the email address [wahlausschuss@asta.uni-siegen.de](mailto:wahlausschuss@asta.uni-siegen.de).

Nominations must include the following information:

- The body for which the candidate wishes to stand
- The name of the electoral list
- First name and surname, or, as a substitute for the first name, the common name
- Student registration number
- A statement confirming that the student consents to their candidacy
- In the case of an election for an FSR, the student's faculty and student council must also be specified

Every student has the right, upon request, to use a first name of their own choosing for their candidacy. Similarly, if a student has several first names, they may specify that only their common name should be used. To do so, the Election Committee simply needs to be informed. An informal email is sufficient for this purpose.

Declarations of consent to stand as a candidate must be made via the student's email address. Otherwise, the Election Committee will not be able to consider the candidacy as binding. This is to verify the person's identity. We ask for your understanding.

In addition, each list must submit a record of the list to the Election Committee by email (wahlausschuss@asta.uni-siegen.de), which must clearly state how the order of candidates on the list was decided. This is to ensure that the order of candidates reflects the list's intentions and to prevent any misunderstandings.

The nominations will be announced to the university community by the Election Committee between 22 May 2026 and 2 June 2026.

## **4. Electoral System**

### **(1) Student Parliament**

For the election of the Student Parliament, the entire student body of the University of Siegen constitutes a single constituency.

- Each voter has three votes
- Voters may distribute their votes amongst candidates from one or more lists, or amongst the lists themselves
- Vote splitting is permitted
- Twenty-five representatives will be elected

### **(2) Student Councils**

For the elections to the Student Councils, each student body constitutes a constituency.

- Each voter has one vote
- Unless otherwise specified, seven seats are allocated per student body
- If a different number of seats is stipulated, the student councils are obliged to notify the Electoral Committee of this by 22 May 2026 at the latest.
- A list must consist of at least one person. Each candidate may only appear on one list at a time

## **5. Voting rights**

### **(1) Student Parliament**

- All students of the University of Siegen who have been enrolled since 1 April 2026 and are listed in the register of voters are eligible to vote and stand for election.
- Visiting students and part-time students are neither eligible to vote nor stand for election.
- Students on a leave of absence are eligible to vote and stand for election.

## **(2) Faculty Councils**

- All students at the University of Siegen who have been enrolled in the relevant faculty since 1 April 2026 and are listed in the electoral register are eligible to vote and stand for election.
- Visiting students and auditors are neither eligible to vote nor stand for election.
- Students on a leave of absence are eligible to vote and stand for election.

## **6. Public display of the electoral roll**

The electoral roll will be made available for public inspection at the AStA office no later than 13 May 2026 and may be viewed during opening hours. Objections to the accuracy of the electoral roll may be lodged until 29 May 2026. Objections must be submitted to the Electoral Committee via the university email address. Any objections to the register of eligible voters submitted after this deadline cannot be upheld, not even by way of a challenge to the election.

## **7. Announcement of the election results**

The online election is counted by the online voting system. The Election Committee receives the results provided and makes them publicly available to the university community. Based on the distribution of votes in the results provided, the Election Committee determines the election result. This is then announced publicly to the university community. The election result remains provisional until the end of the objection period and becomes final upon expiry of the period. The final election result will be announced to the university community via the AStA newsletter, the Instagram accounts of the AStA and the Student Parliament, and a notice displayed in the AStA office.
