Reviewing papers – the process of evaluating a piece of research to determine if it's worthy of being published in a journal – doesn't always come naturally to researchers. Many worry about investing excessive time while aiming to deliver a fair review that is appreciated by authors and journals. Enrolling in a paper reviewing course is essential, providing researchers with the tools to evaluate and offer constructive feedback on academic work efficiently. Acquiring these skills not only bolsters effective contributions to one's field but also ensures rigorous peer review, fostering quality research dissemination and advancing the scholarly community.

This course will instruct you on paper reviewing for international peer-reviewed journals. You'll acquire the essential background knowledge to excel in this skill, coupled with a straightforward roadmap to follow during the reviewing process. Throughout the course, you'll grasp how to craft a review report and efficiently complete review tasks, eliminating the need for extended time commitments. The course comprises numerous short video lessons covering each step of the peer-review process, guiding learners through the review task incrementally. Furthermore, supplementary resources, such as a sample review sheet and a review guide outlining the course's essential steps, are included.

If you are interested, please register as usual using our registration form. Once commenced, the course is accessible for six months.
