Abstracts are important

- for having your contribution/presentation accepted at a conference,
- for having your paper accepted in a journal and
- for ensuring that your publication will be indexed correctly and found (and cited!) by other scientists working in your field.

Writing a good abstract is an art all to itself. How do you include the right buzzwords, all of them, without being overly redundant and repetitive? How do you make strong claims about your results without seeming boastful?

As an abstract is by nature short, we can get a lot of actual work done in this one-day workshop, such as:

- completing real abstracts for your own (past, current, or future) work,
- checking abstracts in highly ranked publications in your field and
- reverse engineering the abstracts of highly ranked publications.

If you have written abstracts before, it might be useful to bring those along; but we can also start from scratch, so feel free to bring publications or DOIs or to come without them; a device with online access will be useful in any case.
