MoveON uses individual terms to describe aspects and status of Online Learning Agreements. In this document you find a an overview of status desciprtions and main terms used yb the provider.

Overview Status Descriptions

Initiated, not shared	LA has been started by the student but is still in progress.
Awaiting Approvel from Student	LA has been completed by the student but has not yet been shared with home institution.
Awaiting Approvel from Sending Institution	LA has been completed and shared with the sending institution. The documents needs to be reviewed and approved by sending institution.
Draft Version	LA with changes proposed by either Sending Institution or Student which have not yet been approved by both. Not shared with Receiving Institution.
Last Shared Version	The version of LA that was last shared with the Receiving Institution.
First Version	The first list of Learning Components approved by Sending Institution, Receiving Institution and student
Latest Proposal	The latest set of LCs suggested by Sending Institution or student.
Last Approved	After First Version, the latest set of Learning Components approved by Sending Institution, Receiving Institution and Student.

Main Terms Used

Learning Agreement	Document shared between Sending Institution, Receiving Institution and student and containing learning outcomes of the mobility.
Learning Components	Educational components i.e., courses, which the student will complete during the mobility.
Mobility Type	Describes the type of mobility. The components available and the processing of the LA will change depending on the mobility type.





Semester Mobility Refers to a semesterwise physical mobility. It may include

optional virtual components. Further "Home Components" or components at the sending institution, that correspond to the courses the student will complete at the receiving institution,

may be added.

Blended Mobility Refers to a mobility where there is at least one course with

virtual aspects.

Doctoral Refers to mobility for doctoral candidates. It may include

optional virtual components.

Stay Components Applicable for semester mobility only. Refers to the

components the student will complete at the receiving

institution.

Home Components Applicable for semester mobility only. Refers to the

components that correspond to the ones the student will

complte at the receiving institution.

Virtual Components Applicable for semester and doctoral mobilities. Refers to the

virtual components the student will complete as part of the

mobility.

Blended Components Applicable for blended mobilities only. At least one of the

blended components must have a virtual aspect.

Doctoral Components Applicable for doctoral mobilities only. Refers to the

components the student will complete as part of the mobility.

Recognition Conditions Refers to the additional conditions required by the sending

institution to recognise the credits for the course the student

will study at the receiving institution.

Information on recognition conditions should only be included in exceptional cases. Automatic recognition should

remain standard procedure.
