



Application Procedure

Erasmus+ Blended Intensive Programme (BIP)

Erasmus+ funding is currently available for Blended Intensive Programmes offered by <u>ATHENA partner universities</u>. Students and PhDs apply at the respective institution abroad. If the application is successful, a Letter of Acceptance is issued and participants register online with the Department International Student Affairs of the University of Siegen to apply for Erasmus+ funding:

Registration

at University of Siegen

Successful applicants register 4 to 8 weeks prior to the start of the BIP via MoveON (link is sent by e-mail) and upload the required application documents to apply for funding.

Learning Agreement

provided by University of Siegen

Once the applications are processed,
Online Learning Agreements are
activated. Students need to complete the
Online Learning Agreement via MoveON.
Guidelines to the OLA are provided here.

Erasmus+ Grant

from University of Sieger

Once the OLA is digitally approved by student, home and host university, a Grant Agreement is issued. A hand-signed hard copy of the Grant Agreement must be submitted before departure.

Recognition

at University of Siegen

Participants submit Learning Agreement and Transcript of Records to the Examination Office. The Proof of Recognition is sent to ISA.

Documentation

at University of Siegen

Participants submit Confirmation of Stay and Transcript of Records (issued by partner university) to document their successful participation.

Blended Mobility

at Partner University

Short-term physical stay abroad and virtual component must be completed successfully. For the blended mobility a minimum of 3 ECTS is awarded.
