## **Excursion report**

I was very happy when I heard that the excursion this year would be in Manchester because I am a football fan and Manchester has two big clubs: Manchester United and Manchester City. In Manchester I visited the official club stores and bought some souvenirs like mugs and flags. I also visited the national football museum in Manchester.
