The electronic course catalogue unisono is now open for registration for Summer Semester 2024 and you can start to plan your schedule for the next semester. From **12.02.2024 - 03.03.2024** you can register for courses via unisono. This is the first registration deadline. There is no "first come, first served" rule, you can use the whole period for the registration. Please find further instructions on course enrollment attached.

The second registration phase is from **18.03.2024 – 31.03.2024** in order to react on your admissions of the first period.

For students who have **started their studies in Winter Semester 2023/24** and will be in their **second semester in the Summer Semester 2024** the following courses/ module elements are obligatory according to the study plan:

### **Module 3: Empirical Research on Democracy (4 SWS, 9 cp)**

- 3.1: Methodology and Methods (3 cp not graded)  
Course: 1SOWI1102V - Principles and Tools of Qualitative Research – Proseminar
- 3.2: Research Seminar (3 cp not graded)  
Course: 1SOWI0703V Qualitative Methods In Researching Mobility an (Forced) Migration - Hauptseminar
- Module examination (3 cp graded)

This module consists of two elements. Please register in unisono for each seminar. The module examination will be registered later. In each of the two seminars 3 credit points must be acquired (Studienleistung). In addition, students must choose one of the three elements/courses in which they complete a graded piece of work for additional 3 credit points (Prüfungsleistung). All in all 9 credit points must be obtained in the overall module.

### **Module 4: Political Cultures and the Public Sphere: Past and Present (4 SWS, 9 cp)**

- 4.1: Comparative Analysis of Political Cultures (3 cp not graded)  
1SOWI1103V Political Culture in Comparative Perspectives – Seminar  
**Or** 1SOWI0406V Changing Norms of Citizenship - Seminar
- 4.2.: Public Sphere and the Media (3 cp not graded)  
1SOWI1105V Populism in Europe
- Module examination (3 cp graded)

This module consists of two elements. Please register in unisono for each lecture. The module examination will be registered later.

In each of the two seminars 3 credit points must be acquired (Studienleistung). In addition, students must choose one of the three elements/courses in which they complete a graded piece of work for additional 3 credit points (Prüfungsleistung). All in all 9 credit points must be obtained in the overall module.

### **3. Thesis Forum I**

Another module element that needs to be completed during Summer Semester is the Thesis Forum I. In case you have already completed the Thesis Forum I you may decide to continue with Thesis Forum II.

Furthermore students have the option of having individual exchange and meetings with professors/ potential supervisors for the Thesis Forum. The work should be confirmed by a paper certificate at the end of the semester and then the certificate needs to be submitted to the examination office.

### **4. Internship**

Furthermore according to the study plan an internship should be completed during the second

semester during the lecture break (**not within the lecture period**). The internship in the second semester is only a suggestion. You may also complete the internship at a later stage of your studies. The internship needs to be registered at the internship office.
