


How to enroll for courses and lectures

You can enroll for courses either through the university's course catalog or the planner of studies with module plan.

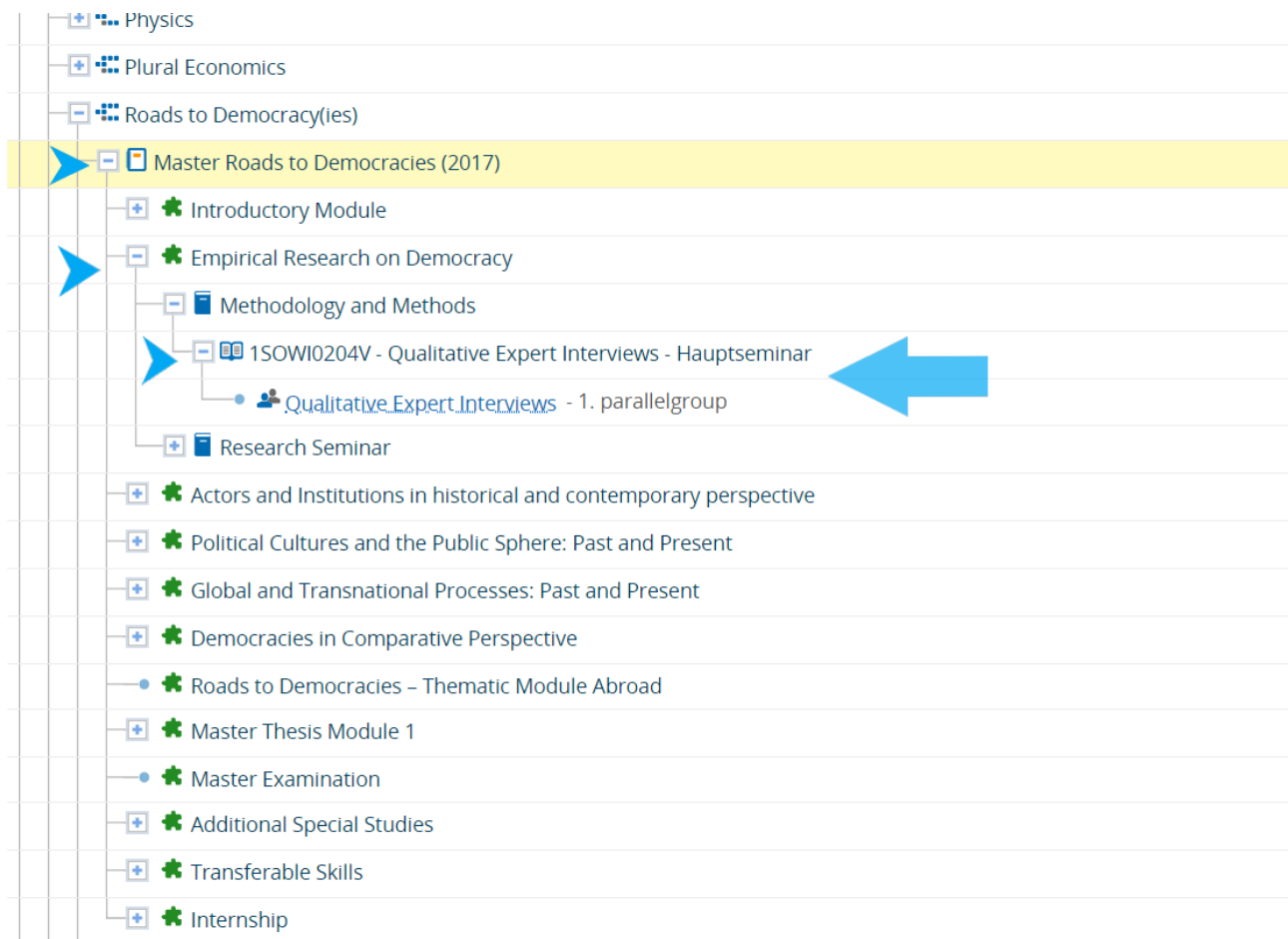

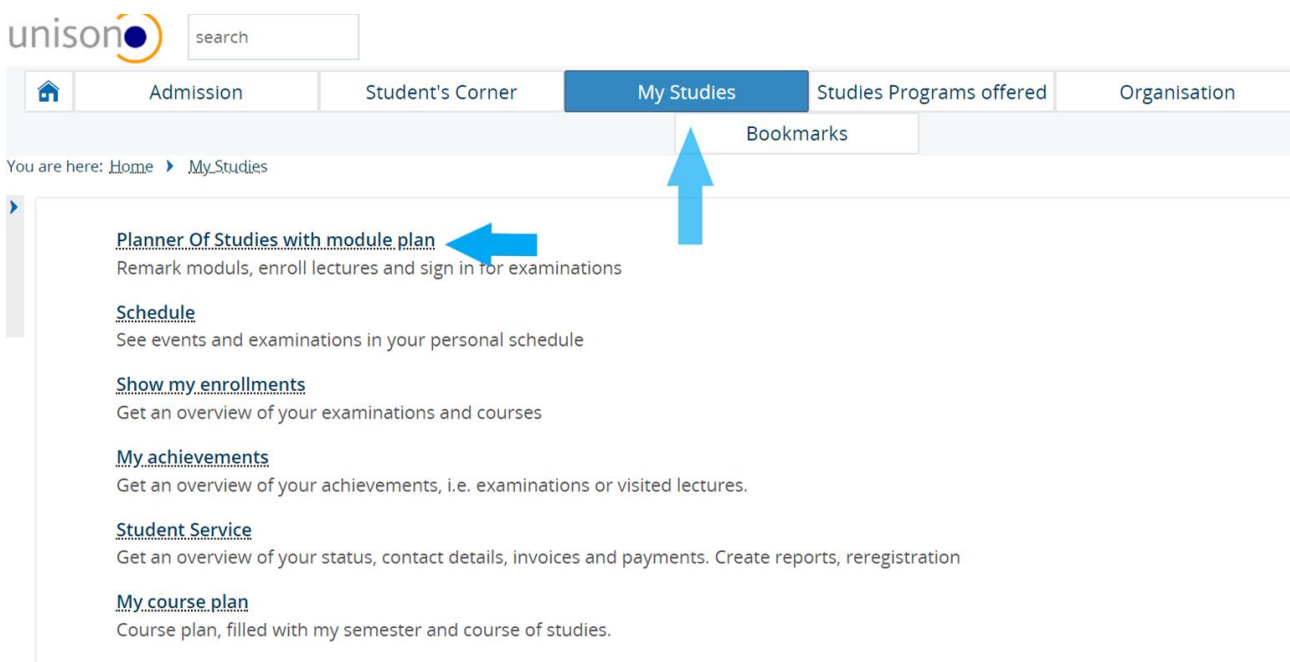
