MSC COFUND STAR

What is STAR? STAR is a training and mobility programme co-funded by the EU, where researchers are given the opportunity to visit the University of Siegen and other organisations around the world for a total of 2-3 years.

Who can apply? STAR will fund 20 experienced researchers of any subject area who either have a PhD degree or at least 4 years full-time equivalent research experience.

What is the scientific background of STAR? The research conducted in STAR must fit at least to one of the 7 research challenges:

Digital and Media Culture • Inclusive Society • Regional Economy in a globalized world • Responsive Sensor Technologies • Smart Materials and Manufacturing • Individualized Health Care • Fundamental Interactions and Particles

How does STAR work? There are two funding options for researchers to select:

OUTGOING: The researcher will spend 12-24 months at a STAR partner organisation (see website for a list) and then 12 months at the University of Siegen

INCOMING: The researcher spends 24 months at a chair at the University of Siegen.

What other benefits are available? Researchers are given the option of temporary research stays at STAR partner organisations; training courses on research and transferable skills; networking opportunities in an outstanding consortium; well equipped financial package and much more.
