

- accessible for all and that creates opportunities for participation in all parts of society.









Some data on the situation in the municipalities



Labour market

- 64 percent of municipalities have employed people with disabilities after completing internships.
- To get more persons with disabilities employed, 64 percent of municipalities collaborate with secondary education and 73 percent with business.



Education

 In 14 percent of the municipalities both public and private schools have been inventoried in terms of physical accessibility.



Culture and Leisure

- 95 percent of the libraries in the municipalities are accessible.
- Four out of five municipalities collaborate with disability organizations on cultural and sports activities.
- There are 20 percent of the municipalities that require accessibility in grants to sporting activities.
