At the University of Siegen, several thousand people – students, staff, and guests – populate the campus daily. Conflicts or unpleasant situations can not always be avoided.

Nevertheless, we do not tolerate harassment, violence or threats of any kind – whether verbal or physical!

Successful learning, research and work is only possible if we feel safe and secure.

Therefore please contact us if:

- » someone displays theatening behavior
- » someone utters threats or implies threats towards third persons
- » you are being molested or stalked
- » someone speaks of or hints at suicide

We take your concerns seriously and arrange a personal conversation with you. If necessary, we take further steps.

This is not about snitching or denouncing someone. Often situations and hazards cannot be evaluated properly without expert knowledge. Remember, however, the person who shows disturbing behavior may need help themselves.

Threat management stands for a **culture of perception and appreciation** – for your and our safety at the campus.

Our employees are trained in the areas of Security, de-escalation and support for affected persons (e.g., when being stalked). We are in connection with other experts as well. If required, we will also provide you with details for counseling and the contact to persons for various threat and stress situations.

All talks are conducted in accordance with the data protection rules.
